

JEANNETTE DINICOLAS MEYER "SHEER PLAY"

Eugene Textile Center, Eugene, Oregon

In person at the Eugene Textile Center on May 31 and June 1! Discover the design and color world which opens up while composing quilts or fabric collages with layers of sheer silk organza and crisp cotton organdy. We will begin by producing a gem-like palette of translucent fabric with water-based paints. We'll use those fabrics in a design exercise that will demonstrate how new colors and shapes emerge as the translucent fabrics are layered and also in a technique sampler notebook of construction methods that exploit the translucent nature



of these fabrics. Some of those construction methods include traditional (hand-sewn) Korean bojagi, my machine-sewn version of that clever seam, as well as other machine and hand-sewn seams that explore the design possibilities different finished and raw edges provide. You'll leave the workshop with an understanding of how to produce the colors of organza you need, how to use these materials in your own designs, and how to employ construction techniques that embrace the inherit property of sheer fabrics.

SEW TEACH ME PROGRAM

Help teach young people to sew!

Become a mentor for the Sew Teach Me Program in Bend. There is a need for additional mentors and teachers.

The commitment is one two-hour training session and two hours one day a week for five weeks during the public school term at the convenience of mentor, student, and Anvil Sewing (they don't have to be consecutive weeks just not too far apart), teaching basic sewing skills to kids 8 to 18 (but seldom older than 14 or 15) starting with a pillowcase.

Mentors have found it very rewarding to share the love of sewing with these young people.

There will be a training session for mentors in July or August with new mentorship beginning in September. There is no charge for the classes. Sewing machines and all supplies are provided. This is a volunteer opportunity - all you provide is your time, expertise and love of sewing!




LEOTIE RICHARDS
